

Spring and fall feasts of the Lord dates 2013-2017 (written June 5th 2012)

Isaiah 56:6" Also the sons of the foreigner (non Jewish born) **Who join themselves to the LORD, to serve Him, And to love the name of the LORD, to be His servants--Everyone who keeps from defiling the Sabbath,** (all Sabbaths, the weekly, the spring and fall feasts of the Lord) **And holds fast My covenant—**(to always be Torah observant of Lord Yeshua, observe dietary laws etc)

Isaiah 56:7 **Even them I will bring** to My holy mountain, And make them joyful in My house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices [Will be] accepted on My altar; For My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations." Isaiah 56:8 The Lord GOD, who gathers the outcasts of Israel, says, "Yet I will gather to him [Others] besides those who are gathered to him

(There is **NOT a lesser Torah,** "the Noahide laws" just for the gentiles as the rabbinic Jews falsely teach for) [Exodus 12:49](#) Exodus 12:49 "One law (Torah) shall be for the native-born and for the stranger who dwells among you." (The rabbinic Jews are cult of man that falsely think they can add to God's Torah, not possible [Deuteronomy 4:2](#), that bogus rabbinic concept is often called the [Takkanah of the rabbis](#))

I have done diligent research these are tentative only for these dates. I always double check each feast date as the date gets closer to observe, you should too! You need to know the moon cycles and related. NASA moon data is pretty handy resource to use.

Yom Kippur etc is based on the Hillel II calendar, established according to rabbinical tradition in 359 CE. **The Hillel II calendar is often off by 2 days, but can be off by 3 days.**

So the following Feast of the Lord dates shared here **are only guidelines,** everyone needs to do their own homework on the "correct" days and dates to observe the Feasts of the Lord of Leviticus 23. Again the rabbinic Jews use the Hillel II calendar and can be off a bit.

Also , everyone needs to do their own homework, The "Feasts of the Lord" are found in [Leviticus 23](#) (Rabbinic Jews are known to celebrate Shavuot on the incorrect date, the 'Feast of weeks" starts on the 1st day of the week and will also conclude on a first day of the week which will always be a Sunday)

Also be sure to always keep the weekly Sabbath. Starts Friday night sundown to sundown, that is the Hebraic perspective. The Hebraic perspectives are the keys that unlock the Bible.

2013

Rosh HaShanah in 2013 will start on Thursday, **the 5th of September**

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Rosh HaShanah on the sunset of Wednesday, the **4th of September.**

Yom Kippur in 2013 is on Saturday, the **14th of September**. Also a “fast” day. No eating sundown to sundown. Often there is a meal afterwards often a gathering called “breaking the fast”

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday **begins on the sunset** of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Yom Kippur on the sunset of Friday, the **13th of September**.

Sukkot in 2013 will start on Thursday, the **19th of September** and will continue for 7 days until Wednesday, the **25th of September**.

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Sukkot on the sunset of Wednesday, the **18th of September**.

2014

Passover in 2014 will start on Tuesday, **the 15th of April** and will continue for 7 days until Monday, the **21st of April**.

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will **celebrate Passover on the sunset of Monday, the 14th of April**.

YFI **Also during April 2014** at some time, something looks to happen to a major world leader, he looks to have been killed but then comes back to life and then Satan enters his body for the duration, till the Lord’s return. Shavuot in 2014 is on Wednesday, the 4th of June (rabbinic). Use Sunday June 8th 2014

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Shavuot on the sunset of Tuesday, the **3rd of June**

Rosh HaShanah in 2014 will start on Thursday, **the 25th of September**

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Rosh HaShanah on the sunset of Wednesday, **the 24th of September**.

Yom Kippur in 2014 is on Saturday, the **4th of October**. Also a “fast” day. No eating sundown to sundown. Often there is a meal afterwards called “breaking the fast”

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Yom Kippur on the sunset of Friday, the **3rd of October**.

Sukkot in 2014 will start on Thursday, the **9th of October** and will continue for 7 days until Wednesday, the **15th of October**.

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Sukkot on the sunset of Wednesday, the **8th of October**

2015

Passover in 2015 will start on **Saturday, the 4th of April** and will continue for 7 days until Friday, the **10th of April**.

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Passover on the sunset of Friday, the **3rd of April**.

Shavuot in 2015 is on Sunday, the **24th of May**. **May 24th Sunday**

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Shavuot on the sunset of Saturday, the **23rd of May**.

Rosh HaShanah in 2015 will start on Monday, the **14th of September** and will continue for 2 days until Tuesday, the **15th of September**.

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Rosh HaShanah on the sunset of Sunday, the **13th of September**.

Yom Kippur in 2015 is on Wednesday, the **23rd of September**. Also a “fast” day. No eating sundown to sundown. Often there is a meal afterwards called “breaking the fast”

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Yom Kippur on the sunset of Tuesday, the **22nd of September**.

Sukkoth in 2015 will start on Monday, the **28th of September** and will continue for 7 days until Sunday, the **4th of October**.

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Sukkoth on the sunset of Sunday, the **27th of September**.

2016

Passover in 2016 will start on Saturday, the **23rd of April** and will continue for 7 days until Friday, the **29th of April**.

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Passover on the sunset of Friday, the **22nd of April**.

Shavuot in 2016 is on **Sunday, the 12th of June**.

Rosh HaShanah in 2016 will start on Monday, the **3rd of October** and will continue for 2 days until Tuesday, the **4th of October**.

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Rosh HaShanah on the sunset of Sunday, the **2nd of October**.

Yom Kippur in 2016 is on Wednesday, **the 12th of October**. Also a “fast” day. No eating sundown to sundown. Often there is a meal afterwards called “breaking the fast”

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Yom Kippur on the sunset of Tuesday, the **11th of October**.

Sukkoth in 2016 will start on Monday, the **17th of October** and will continue for 7 days until Sunday, the **23rd of October**.

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Sukkoth on the sunset of Sunday, the **16th of October**.

2017

Passover in 2017 will start on Tuesday, **the 11th of April** and will continue for 7 days until Monday, the **17th of April**.

In the USA, Passover ends one day later, so in 2017, Passover will end on Tuesday, the **18th of April**.

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Passover on the sunset of Monday, the **10th of April**.

Shavuot in 2017 is on ~~Wednesday, the 31st of May (rabbinic)~~. Use this date **Sunday June 4th 2017**

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Shavuot on the sunset of Tuesday, the **30th of May**.

Rosh HaShanah in 2017 will start on Thursday, the **21st of September** and will continue for 2 days until Friday, the **22nd of September**.

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Rosh HaShanah on the sunset of Wednesday, the **20th of September**.

Between Rosh HaShanna and Yom Kippur the Israel Sanhidern looks to reconvien to have a retrial of Lord Yeshua and then find Him completely innocent of all charges against Him and then return on Yom Kippur 2017 to deliver Israel from its enemies.

(Hosea 5:15 I will go and return to my place (heaven), **till they acknowledge their offence**) That is Israel will have a retrial and to admit that they wrongly tried Yeshua. Israel will then have a retrial **during the last ten days**, during the days of AWE and will find Lord Yeshua completely innocent of all charges against Him and likely read **Isaiah 53 (which speaks of Messiah Yeshua)** as part of their proclamation of finding Lord Yeshua completely innocent of all charges against Him. Then in this passage of Hosea is speaks of Israel. Hosea 6:2 After two days will he revive us: (during the days of AWE) in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight. (Then the true Messiah of Israel, Lord Yeshua will return to earth a few days later **on Yom Kippur** with His "sons of light" to deliver Israel from its enemies) When that event occurs the world will have come face to face with God! **Face to face** is a Yom Kippur idiom.

Yom Kippur in 2017 is on Saturday, the **30th of September**.

Yom Kippur 2017 looks to be the "**Day of the Lord**" The Lord Yeshua's return date with His "sons of light" Torah observant of non rabbinic practices, not a follow of Paul

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Yom Kippur on the sunset of Friday, the **29th of September**.

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Shavuot on the sunset of Tuesday, the **30th of May**

Sukkot in 2017 will start on Thursday, the **5th of October** and will continue for 7 days until Wednesday, the **11th of October**.

Note that in the Jewish calendar, a holiday begins on the sunset of the previous day, so observing Jews will celebrate Sukkot on the sunset of Wednesday, the **4th of October**.
